

FAQs TO REMEMBER (PLEASE READ)

COUPLE-PHOTOGRAPHER

NINE DAYS BEFORE THE WEDDING (NO LATER THAN).

- Make sure we have received all paperwork needed for the wedding day; such as: Wedding poses selection and wedding schedule agreement sheet. Please leave blank unsure options on agreement sheet; miles and extra time will be added to invoice and payable when first product pick up.
- Make sure we have received Wedding package balance (Please ask for total including taxes when ready to make payment).
- If we have agreed on engagement video clip or wedding photo package includes video clip: we need to count on about 60 total personal photos. Remember, more is not longer, just more crowded. Please consider those images to create a story from newborn to latest days in the individual person's life including (if wanted) images from their family and friends (About 25 total images of each person recommended). Video can be enhanced with about 10 miscellaneous images of the couple together. 25 (Her)+25 (Him)+10 (Couple)=60 images.
- If the last option is applicable to wedding package, we would also need two chosen songs selected for background. Can be audio CD, mp3 or written down (specify singer and version). Consider the first choice to be for all 60 images background and second choice for engagement and video data background.
- Meeting for all the above is also optional; but your presence is not an obligation; however, we do not recommend shipping family photo memories that could get lost in mail. For that we will accept (If needed) scanned data of at least 200 dpi resolution on CD containing three folders: Her, him and Couple. Please do not title the image names with words; Please number them in chronological order.

TO CONSIDER

WEDDING PLANING

- Make sure ceremony and reception time match the photo needs. If necessary look for sunset time on wedding day to determine if there's enough day light for outdoor photos after ceremony if outdoor photos are wanted.
- If outdoor photos are wanted; look for options available in the area (Buildings, Bridges, Parks, fields etc.)
- Make appointment for engagement photos at least two months before wedding. Specify time, place, dead lines and if video footage is going to be made of session.
- Make sure DJ (If scheduled) will be at reception to entertain until couple arrives. If necessary talk to DJ about photo needs; perhaps to make sure that main activities fit in photography time schedule (remember that extra time is also available).
- Make sure guys try tuxes on when first notice of arrival. Avoid last minute try.
- If transportation is hired make sure they are schedule to be there at least 15 minutes before planning to walk out of the church.
- Announce to people during rehearsal the importance of their "on time" presence for photos and cooperation. Maybe, schedule them to be ready 15 minutes before needed.

FOR THE WEDDING DAY

- If runner, Make sure is not pinned until after photos.
- It is better to do makeup before dress is on; but if necessary to do after, cover front of dress to protect.
- Consider a "bride emergency bag" (Nail polish remover, wet wipes, safety pins, needle and thread, etc).
- Have water or drinks available to couple and/or wedding party.
- Some kind of food may be sometimes a option before ceremony; some times the day starts getting long around lunch time after all the day preparations and the accomplishment of some or all the formal photos.
- Please remember that being on time helps us accomplish the results of your photo memories at its best.
